

Language Institute Thammasat University TU006 English 2 Course Outline Semester 1/2019

Pre-requisite: TU005 English 1

Course Description:

This course is designed to improve students' writing skills. Emphasis is placed on developing the skills of writing sentences and paragraphs.

Learning Outcomes:

Upon successful completion of the course, students will be able to:

- 1) distinguish various types of paragraph including narration, description, instruction, process, cause-effect, comparison/contrast, and opinion paragraphs;
- 2) write sentences and paragraphs in various types as mentioned in 1); and,
- 3) make use of appropriate phrases and structure learned in class to compose writing pieces in both sentence and paragraph levels.

Textbook/Teaching Materials:

TU006 English 2 (2018) by Language Institute, Thammasat University

Active Learning Activities:

Students will practice writing skills in class through a variety of active activities including pair/group work and group discussion. The practice of analyzing and composing various types of paragraph will also be promoted.

In order to pass this course, students are required to obtain at least 55% of the total score (110 points) and to attend at least 80% of all classes.
